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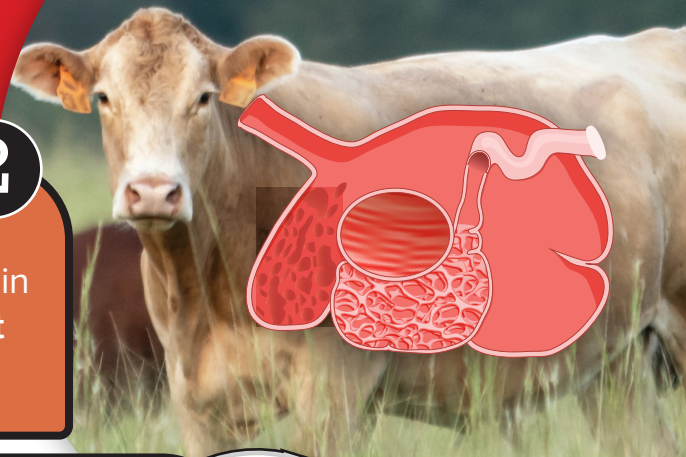
Cool Facts About Cattle

2 Cattle use their special stomach to digest grass in a way that humans can't and turn it into beef!¹



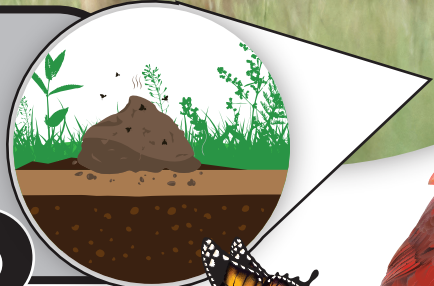
3 Cattle burps are part of a natural cycle. The gases they release only stay in the atmosphere for a 10 years before they return to the soil.⁷
